<b>Field Marshal's Report</b>	No fertilizer is required; field is in good shape
<b>Training Report</b>	Nothing to report
<b>Webmaster's Report</b>	Nothing to report
<b>AMA Report</b>	Jay Marsh was elected Associate Vice President District 4 of AMA
<b>Safety Report</b>	It was noted that pilots should make sure that their batteries are charged properly prior to flying
<b>Old Business</b>	<i>Review of Warbird Event:</i> Warbird entry fees collected = \$310.00 Warbird raffle = \$294
<b>New Business</b>	A member suggested the use of solar panels for charging batteries in the future  Christmas Party will be held at Messiah 2 on December 3 <sup>rd</sup> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Social hour starts at 6 PM</li><li>• Dining starts at 7 PM</li><li>• Cost is \$15/person; Sign-up sheet will be at KC Hobby; if you sign-up before Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>, you will be given 1 raffle ticket to be entered in the Airplane Raffle;</li></ul>

- Airplane Raffle: Marsh requested \$300 for raffle; motion granted

President Walton commented on Safety program; Everyone should read AMA safety rules; every year you re-up your membership, you must re-read the rules

Everyone should have a copy of name and phone number in their planes in accordance with AMA

Basic first-aid procedures were distributed to all that were present

Runway should only be used for landing, taking off and touch-and-go's; all other flight activities, such as aerobatics, should be done on the other side of the far berm

Animals are prohibited on the runway; Unauthorized people should remain behind the fence

Jesse has requested and will remove 2 flight boxes

President Walton reiterates importance of letting people know the direction of your flight so there aren't any near-misses. Spotters are recommended; if you see someone without a spotter and there are two or more people flying, it is recommended that you spot for them, where possible

F3K hand-launch glider competition has requested to hold an event on Dec 10 from 9am to 2pm at the field; estimate of 20 pilots will be in the competition; landing fee is \$10; estimated club profits will be \$200; visiting club will take care of their own needs and Jesse will be the CD for our club for this event; motion was carried and agreed upon to allow event to take place

Discussion was made on best location to post events; KC Hobby, via email and location on bulletin board to be determined

Motion was carried that a no smoking sign be placed in the kitchen; no smoking, chewing, dip, or any other tobacco products inside the kitchen area; for health and sanitary reasons
